Greetings Maple View Families:

As we finish our first week back from winter break, we have a number of important things happening in the near future. Our current 6th and 7th grade students will be meeting with the counselors this coming Tuesday and Wednesday to register for their 2020-2021 classes. Counselors will help students to understand their options for classes and send students home with their registration materials home for you to review. Registrations will need to be completed by January 23rd. We are registering earlier so we can get to work on next year's master schedule and be ready to hire teachers during March and April when the best candidates are available. We will be doing the same process with current 5th grade students in a couple of weeks and then with current 8th grade students a couple of weeks after that.

The end of the first semester is two weeks from today, Friday January 24th. It is important that you log into Family Access with your student to make sure everything is turned in, made up and ready to go. This will ensure that your student gets a grade that is an accurate reflection of the work completed in the past 90 days. If you have any questions about a specific class, contact your student's teacher to get clarification.

With the end of semester nearing, we would like to make you aware of the Awards Night we host at the end of the school year. Maple View recognizes outstanding students by awarding a series of academic and department awards as well as excellence in attendance.

GPA Awards are given to students who have academic excellence. There are two types of GPA recognition: 1) a certificate for cumulative GPA of 3.5-3.999, 2) a plaque for cumulative GPA of 4.0. The cumulative GPA for students begins in 6th grade and continues with them through the end of 8th grade.

Department Awards are given by each department that make up the various classes. Teachers nominate students based on the following criteria: work ethic/improved work ethic, attitude in class, positive impact on class, and improvement in class grade. Students must have a minimum of a "C" on the semester report card.

Excellent Attendance Awards are given to those students with who attended school EVERY day and were never tardy to class for the entire 1st, 2nd and 3rd quarter.
