Just a couple of items coming up next week and some great information from our nurse.

MATERIALS DISTRIBUTION

We are ramping up for our 2nd distribution, this coming Thursday, 10/1. This will be a ONE DAY event from 9am to 6pm.

What will be distributed?

- **Supplies for ALL math classes (*EXCEPT: Algebra and Geometry*)**
- **Supplies for ALL art classes: 2D, 3D, Digital and Exploratory 6th grade art**

This will be a drive-through pick-up.

FOOD DRIVE

We are running a food drive to benefit the Maple Valley Food Bank. Drop off your donations during the materials distribution on 10/1.

What can be donated?

Canned food: Meats (tuna, chicken, salmon, etc.), vegetables, fruit, hearty soups, chili, ravioli, stew, etc. Tomato products (whole, stewed, diced, sauces).

Packaged food: Peanut butter, cereal, oatmeal, pasta, meal in a box (Hamburger or Tuna Helper), macaroni & cheese, pancake mix, rice, flour, macaroni and cheese, etc.

Hygiene items: Shampoo, toilet paper, toothpaste, soap, feminine products, deodorant, etc.

Baby cupboard items: Diapers, diaper wipes, formula, baby food, etc.

*All food items should be within one year of the expiration date.

PLEASE NOTE: We cannot accept donations of used clothing or household items. In the interest of food safety, we cannot distribute out of date, opened containers, or home cooked/canned food to our clients.

Notes from the Nurse:

Is your student missing any of the State Required Vaccinations to attend school? If so, they must be completed and the documentation must be turned in BEFORE your student can attend school in person this year. The Seattle Visiting Nursing Association is hosting a series of Drive-Thru FREE vaccine clinics in Kent at the beginning of October. No registration needed for childhood vaccines. Flu shots will also be available by appointment for community members ages 4+ and are highly recommended this year due to the Coronavirus Outbreak. If you would like an exemption, please call your healthcare provider to schedule an appointment to discuss.
