REGISTRATION

In January 2021, the MVMS Counseling Center will be starting 7th and 8th Grade Registration. This is the process of registering current 6th and 7th grade students for classes for the 2021-2022 school year.

- January 7th: Registration packets will be included in the student materials at supply pickup at MVMS. **Please keep this packet!**
- January 29th: In Homeroom, teachers will provide a registration lesson that instructs students on how to select and register for elective classes online via Skyward.
- January 29th (at noon) to February 5th (at 11:59 pm): Families will have this window to enter elective choices in Skyward.
- February 5th: In Homeroom, students will complete an online Google form in class to record their elective choices. This will help with accurate scheduling. It is <u>not</u> required for students to submit paper copy registration forms during remote learning.

More information will be provided regarding current 5th graders registering for 6th grade in February. Current 8th graders will be registering for high school courses in March.
