

Greetings Maple View Middle School Families and Students,

As we prepare to shift into our newest hybrid model and develop new protocols to support student learning and safety, there is much that we want to share with each of you to help with this transition. Prior to the first week of hybrid learning, beginning on March 29, please use this checklist and make sure that your family is aware of the following details and information:

- Watch our welcome back video, "Welcome to Concurrent Learning" (~12 mins) and "Hybrid Homeroom Lesson" presentation highlighting key components of our return to in-person instruction.
 - Welcome to Concurrent LearningHybrid Homeroom Lesson

 - Both students and parents should be aware of <u>drop-off and pick-up procedures</u> in the morning and afternoon. Remember, due to health protocols, students will remain outside until 8:50 a.m. each day and need to wait in designated lines with social distancing markers.
 - o Remember, parents will complete the attestation daily for every student coming to campus. If your child is not feeling well, please keep them home and if possible, stream into classes via Zoom.
- Review Tech Requirements, specifically the requirement students bring their laptop back and forth to school every day they are on campus.
 - Families are encouraged to purchase insurance to cover loss/theft/breakage of TSD borrowed devices for \$10.
- Review our "Return to School Handbook" MVMS Return to School Handbook
 - o One area of focus is to understand the directions for snacking and drinking water during school, while keeping a mask on.
- Log into Skyward and read the "Hybrid Pre-Arrival Agreement" (available 3/23/2021) -Skyward - TSD
