This month's highlighted Future Ready Skill is "Strategic Problem-Solver". **Strategic problemsolvers** begin by clearly and accurately defining the problem or challenge that needs solving. As they do so, they seek to understand and consider the current reality and complexities of the problem from multiple points of view. Next, they brainstorm and consider a range of creative solutions before selecting the most appropriate possible solution(s). Once a possible solution has been identified, **strategic problem-solvers** develop an action plan and maintain a focus on the goal(s). As they work toward the solution, they exhibit stamina, revisiting, reflecting critically on, and revising the process at each stage. Throughout the process, and especially at the end, they identify where the process and solution could be improved, modifying when needed.
