## **MVMS food services UPDATE:**

Breakfasts and lunches will continue to be free for all students for the 2021-2022 school year. Every student may pick up 1 breakfast and 1 lunch per day. Breakfast will be served a bit differently to track the number of meals served and for contract tracing. The cashiers are using the point of sale system and students are entering their student ID numbers. Students may use hand sanitizers after they have picked up their school breakfast and lunch. Hand sanitizer is available in the cafeteria. Students that don't know their number will have to wait in line while the cashier looks up their ID number in the system. **Students are encouraged to learn their student ID number.** It speeds up the lines, and students have more time to eat breakfast and get back to their classrooms.
